



PAKISTAN SITUATION REPORT

June 26 - September 22 2025

CONTEXT UPDATE

Over the recent decades, Pakistan continues to face increasingly frequent and intense floods due to climate change, that has severely impacted the lives, livelihoods and infrastructure in the country. After the devastating floods of 2010 and 2022, Pakistan is once again at the forefront of another climate induced catastrophe. The ongoing floods have impacted over 6.9 million (over 4.7 million in Punjab and 1.6 million in KP Province) since 26 June damaging over 7000 houses and cutting off the linkages between key roads.

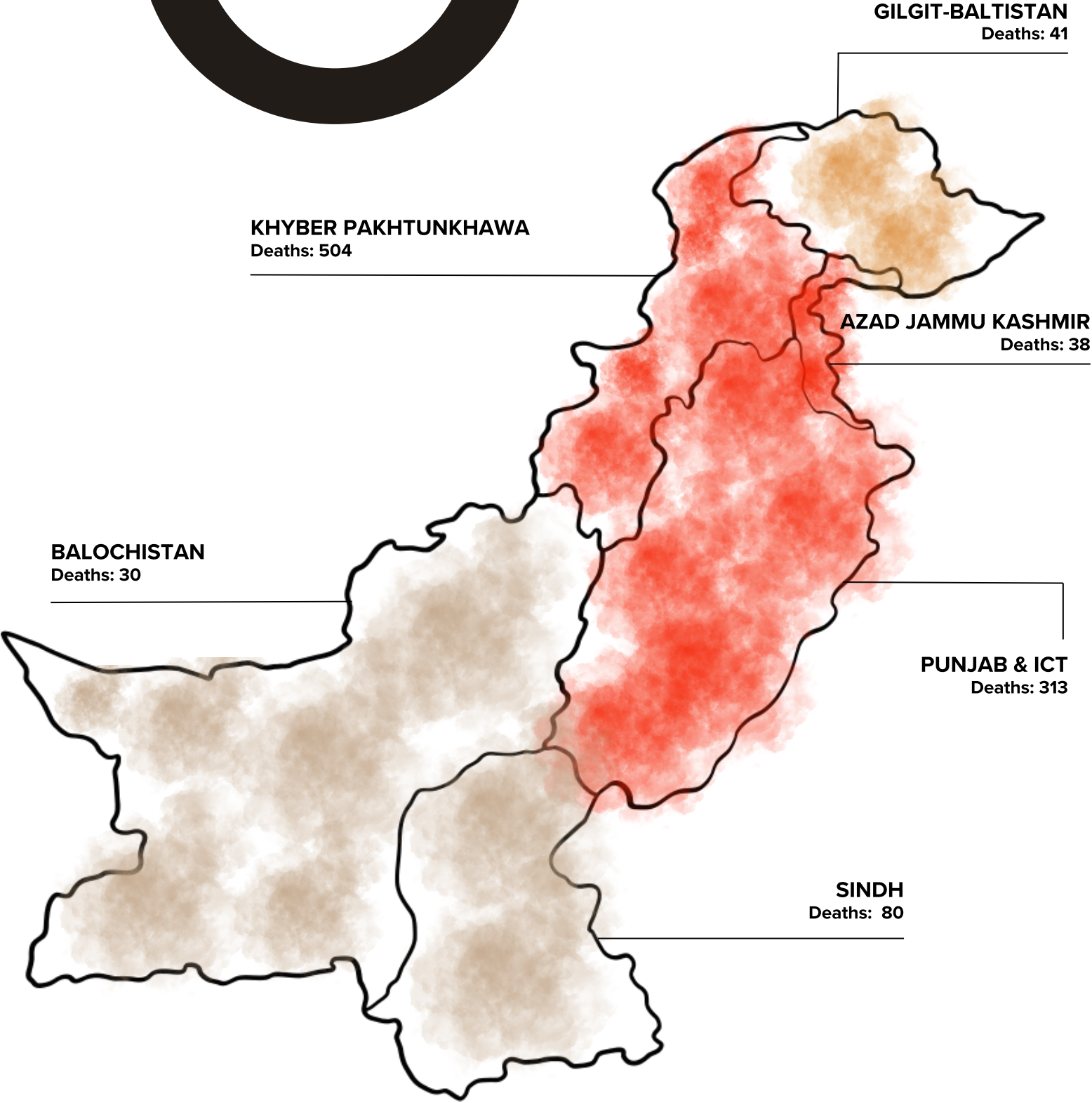
In Punjab, the town of Alipur with a population of 40,000 was completely submerged, while in Jalalpur Pirwala alone, nearly 100,000 people had to be evacuated. Over 2.5 million acres of farmland have been damaged in Punjab and around 3 million people were evacuated, with 150,000 still in evacuation centers, as large areas, particularly in Multan and Muzaffargarh, remain submerged.

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) province faces a dengue fever outbreak with 1,329 confirmed across the province, including 55 new cases in the last 24 hours.

Authorities warn of a new spell of heavy rains as floodwaters surge downstream into Sindh, pushing the Indus River to perilous levels and inundating riverine communities. With conditions expected to deteriorate further, humanitarian needs will grow more urgent..

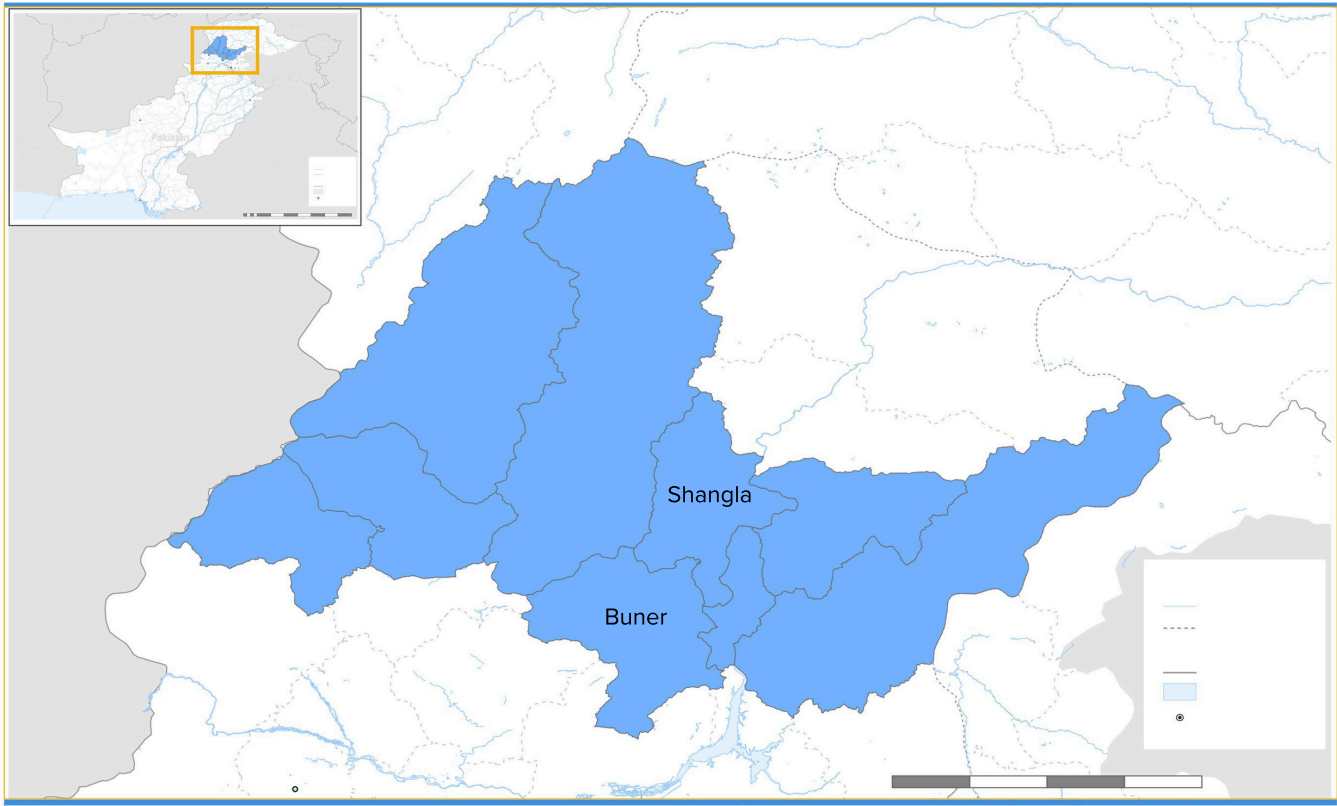
RAPID NEEDS ASSESSMENT

Action for Humanity Pakistan (AFHP) visited the flood affected communities in Koh Suleman, Tribal belt, Tehsil Taunsa; Tehsil Paroa, District DI Khan and Shangla to conduct a detailed Rapid Needs Assessment using different tools for collecting information

- 1.Focus Group Discussions (FGDs) with affected communities
- 2.Informant Interviews (KIIs) with local stakeholders and government representatives
- 3.Household-level assessments of 410 families using the standardized RNA tool

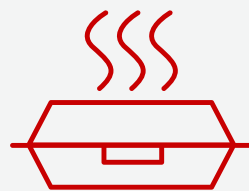
